

DEFENSIVE AND COMPETITIVE BIDDING
OVERCALLS (Style: Responses: 1 / 2 Level; Reopening)
Style: natural/aggressive
1 level = Natural (5+ cards, can have 4 card)
2 level = Natural (5+ cards)
Raise = Jumping is weak, cue is forcing, jump cue is splinter, 2NT = fit 4+sup, 10+hcp
Reopening = suit 7-13, double 7-10 or 14+ any
1NT OVERCALL (2nd/4th Live; Responses; Reopening)
Natural: 15-18 balanced (likely to have stopper in opponents suit)
Responses: like on our opening
Reopening: 1NT = 11-14(if p has bid) 17-18(if p has passed)
Responses: Only cue is forcing
JUMP OVERCALLS (Style; Responses; Unusual NT)
Weak: Usually Decent in neg vul. Reopen: Shape or strong
OVER OPPONENTS’ TAKEOUT DOUBLE
Redouble = 10+ or Support for Partner new suit = NF
jump in a new suit = limit (nat. or fit 4°)

VS. NT (vs. Strong/Weak; Reopening;PH)
Dbl – minor + major ; 2C – both major; 2D – Single Suiter Major;
2H – H+m; 2S – S+m; 2nt – minors, 3c/3d – suit
Vs. weak NT (10-12/12-14)
Dbl – 14+, 2c – MM, 2d – 5+h (upto 17), 2h – 5+s (upto 17)
